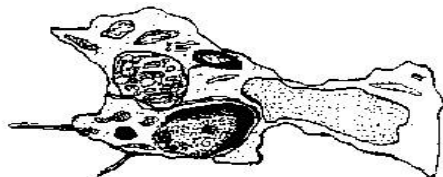

**PLACE: El Escorial Monastery, Madrid, Spain**



The meeting of the Cell Death Society scheduled for 6-9 May 2000 will be held in the Infantes Training Centre in El Escorial, Spain. The Centre is the renovated 19th century Casa de Infantes palace.

San Lorenzo de El Escorial, located 50 Km northwest of Madrid, is famed for the imposing Monastery built by King Philip II in the 1500's. Nestled in the Guadarrama mountains at approximately 1,000 meters above sea level, it is surrounded by woods and pine forests. The town itself was developed in the 18th century, as reflected in its singular architectural style with granite streets, porticos, stairways, plazas, fountains and terraces. In addition to the Monastery and associated historical sites, the town offers numerous cultural, gastronomic, and recreational opportunities. Madrid can be reached in about 45 minutes by train, bus or highway.
